

# WHO IS TRIP PAGE?

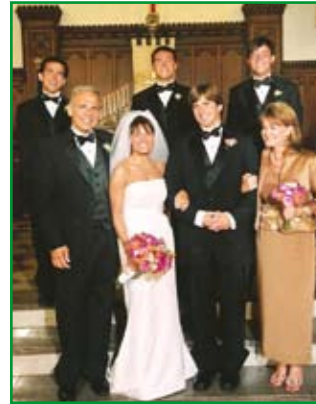
