David Rogers is Richland Construction B's RCE

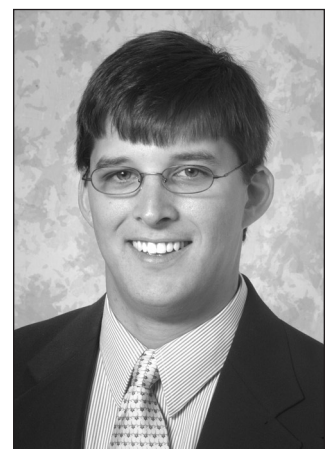
David L. Rogers, of Columbia, has been promoted to Resident Construction Engineer in Richland Construction Office B.
